



COVID-19 Student Mask & Quarantine Policy Update

December 1, 2021

I. Student Mask Policy

- a. Due to a recent Legislative bill, signed by Governor Ron DeSantis, masks will be optional for all K-8 students.
 - i. If your child forgets his or her mask, one will only be provided if (and only if) the student requests a mask
 - ii. Otherwise we will assume that it is the parents' choice to not have their student wear a mask
 - iii. Note: Trinity School for Children must comply with State Law. If State law changes, we must adapt to those changes and update our policies

II. Communication Expectations

- a. Our goal continues to be focused on the successful education of our students
- b. With that in mind, we do not expect to have further correspondence about mask wearing at Trinity unless State of Florida law changes.

III. Contact Tracing & Quarantining

- a. Reminder
 - i. The Surgeon General of the State of Florida – Emergency Order
 1. If a student is identified as a close-contact to a COVID-19 individual and is asymptomatic:
 - a. It is the parents right to chose whether their child quarantines at home or attends school
 - i. As long as the student remains symptom free
