



# K-8th Grade Charter *Lottery & Wait List Procedures*

## Applications

Parents/Guardians are able to obtain an application in the following manner:

- Trinity School for Children's Website ([www.trinitysfc.org](http://www.trinitysfc.org)) -- Quick Links & Admissions Page
- Contacting the Admissions Office and requesting an application
- School Tours
- School Office

All applications must be submitted to the Admissions Office by 4:00pm, on the last Thursday in January.

The number of seats available will be determined by the number of students who recommit by Letters of Intent, minus the capacity. Enrollment preference is given to the following student population:

- Students who are siblings enrolled in Trinity School for Children
- Students who are children of a member of the Governing Board of Trinity School for Children
- Students who are children of an employee of Trinity School for Children
- Students who have successfully completed Trinity School for Children's Early Childhood Program. (Parents/Guardians of Trinity School for Children's Early Childhood students do not need to complete the K-8 Application)
- Students who are children of an active duty member of any branch of the United States Armed Forces

## Random Lottery

All eligible applicants are assigned a random number and are sorted by entering grade.

The random Lottery is conducted the second or third Monday in February for all available seats per grade level. Applicants are randomly selected using a computer generated randomizer by Administration and Admissions.

Once the random Lottery is complete, applicants selected will be notified by the Admissions Director.

All applications received after the Lottery has been conducted will be "Date Stamped" and placed on a wait list.

Trinity School for Children shall **not** discriminate against any prospective students on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, or any other legally protected status.
